## AUDIO-VISUAL MATERIALS, cont.

- Think TB: A Program for Physicians.** 15 minutes.
- Tuberculosis in the Institutional Environment Compliance Kit.** Assists facilities whose employees have risk of exposure to TB. Helps employees understand the nature of the disease, as well as what they can do to protect themselves from infection.
- How-to-Mantoux Kit.** A training kit, consisting of a model arm, video and caliper, is available on loan to learn or re-learn the correct technique for administering, reading and interpreting the Mantoux PPD skin test.

### **NO COST FOR TUBERCULOSIS CARE.**

Costs related to the evaluation and treatment of TB are covered by the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) and paid at DIM (Medicaid) rates when not covered by a patient's medical insurance (i.e., private, Medicare, Medicaid). Services covered are diagnostic testing, radiology, office visits and most hospitalizations due to complications attributable to TB. Drugs are provided by the DPH directly to the physician who is supervising the patient's TB treatment.
